Our Scarborough.




"I feel like they [media outlets] don't really portray





"When I first moved there I did research on my area and I found out there were gangs. I was young at the time so I was scared to go outside."


"After living there for a while,

"I feel like everyone doesn't know much about Scarborough, but from what I've seen on social media, it's definitely portrayed in a bad way."










